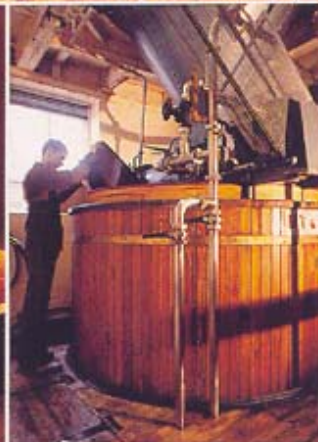

A message from the Chairman

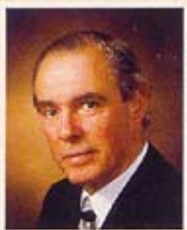


In the early 1870's, my grandfather took the decision to leave farming and concentrate on brewing beer – a decision which has found favour with generations of beer drinkers ever since.



Originally, the beer was destined for local farmworkers mainly during harvest time, but over the years our traditional brewing techniques and equipment, created national and international demand for Batemans. By pony and trap, horse and dray, steam wagon, train, hard tyred lorry and ultimately via our present fleet of modern curtain-sided lorries, our beers have been transported to a growing number of beer drinkers.

Today, Batemans beers are enjoyed in a wide cross section of licensed locations, including almost a hundred of our own tenanted pubs, all of which display the 'Good Honest Ales' slogan, conceived by my father in the 1920's. Our ales are backed by good honest service too, a philosophy of which my forbears would have been justly proud.
